

School Fees 2021 – 2022*



Instalment payments can only be made by Direct Debit. Direct debits can be made annually, termly or monthly. Monthly payment options must be set up via Go Cardless Direct Debit and will be taken by the 15th of the month.

School Day

The school day starts at 08.30 – 15.25. Wrap around care until 18.00 is provided for our primary pupils from Foundation to Year 6 at an additional cost (see below).

Breakfast Club is available from 08.00 in the Dining Hall. There is no additional supervision charge for this provision and pupils can purchase breakfast items from the canteen.

Annual Fees

Our annual fees cover the cost of tuition, assessments, examination fees, routine educational trips, access to our Wellbeing and Additional Learning Needs (ALN) Faculty and necessary books and materials for learning and teaching within the classroom. It also covers the cost of access to our online learning platform and access to our online classes.

Online Fees (OF)

Online fees take into account that pupils will not be accessing the school site and facilities. The fees include:

- Onsite access to end of year examinations in preparation for GCSEs and A Levels.
- Access to our Literacy Club.
- All costs of external examinations taken through our online curriculum.

Early Payment Option

Parents can benefit from an early payment discount. In order to access this, fees must be paid by the following dates.

- **Annual payments** – paid in full annually no later than 31st August for the following academic year.
- **Termly payments** – paid in full no later than the dates below for the following academic term:
 - Autumn Term – 05th September
 - Spring Term – 05th January
 - Summer Term – 05th May

Direct Debits – parents can also benefit from EPO if a monthly Direct Debit is set up and maintained for the 12 months of payment

EU Pre-Settlement/Settlement Status & International Dependent Visas

Pupils who attend Kings Monkton School under EU Pre-Settlement/Settlement status or as dependent upon their parents or other care giver visas have the following fees:

Registration Deposit - £500

This is made up of a £50 non-returnable administration fee and £450 deposit that is held on account and returnable to the pupil once they leave Kings Monkton School, and subject to full settlement of any outstanding fees.

Fees must be paid, either annually or termly by the following dates. Failure to do so will mean parents cannot access the Early Repayment Option and will be responsible for full fees as stated on our School Fees Document:

- Annual payments – paid in full annually no later than 20th August for the following academic year.
- Termly payments – paid in full no later than the dates below for the following academic term:
 - Autumn Term – 5th September
 - Spring Term – 5th January
 - Summer Term – 5th May

Scholarships

Scholarships, worth up to 20% of fees, are available in the January of Year 2; Year 6; Year 9 and Year 11. Scholarships are based on the school's scholarship examination and are awarded to the top performers in the year group.

Notice Periods

When your child leaves the school, you must give one full term written notice to the school office, addressed to the Principal, otherwise you will be liable to pay for one terms fee.
